Discipline Committee:

Ken asked again about the stipend for Dave Carmody.
Dan recommended we send the amount of the stipend.

Other Business.

Bruno asked about Professional insurance coverage. Al said that they are signed through USSF.

CSSA – Suspended Club Napoli for Cup infractions. They posted bond. Subsequent red cards in league play resulted in letter from Dan laying out future punishment. Nature of current infractions was individual. Long discussion followed. How many individual offenses constitute a “team” offense? Lines need to be drawn. Need more specificity in punishments and consequences. The question is what do we do now. Motion made that the bond is forfeit and Club Napoli must repost \$500 Bond. Passed unanimously.

Norwalk Manager played himself under another player pass. He had been suspended for a prior red card. Discipline in proscribed in Cup and CSSA playing rules.

New Business:
